Gisborne Botanical Gardens



Gisborne Botanical Gardens is a nice walk and a nice drive, not too far (around 20 minutes from Sunbury) which is good for puppies who need to get use to car travel.

There is parking available at the playground and picnic area on Gisborne Kilmore Road.

There is a playground, benches, tables, BBQs, Bins and public toilets.

Following the path go through the underpass this will take you to an open area (great for practicing training) near another playground, unfortunately there is no off lead areas in the area ☹️ but if you have an extendable lead your dog can have more room to run around in and can be used to practice recalls on lead (just make sure they don't tie people up)

There is a variety of different plants in this area which attract native birds to the area and making this a great place to sit and relax with your dog(s), family and friends, and just watch the world and other people.

Or plenty of room to go running with your dog.

So go for a drive and go for a walk, because walks should be exciting and new every now and then.

Make sure you take a bowl and a bottle of water for your dog with you and let your dog have a drink when you get back to your car.
