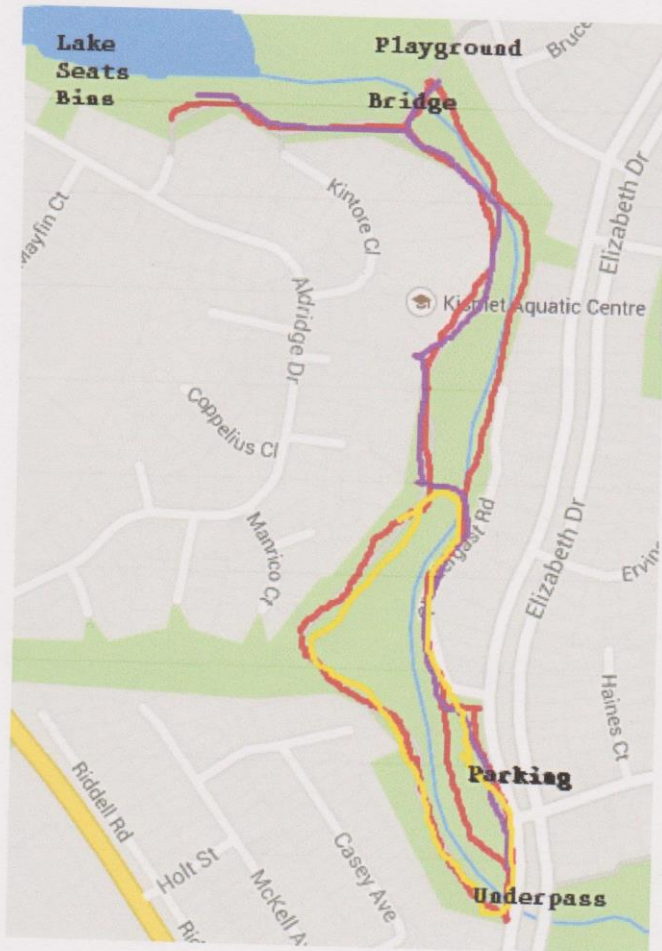


# Walk Of The Month

# Spavin Lake



This walk follows part of Kismet creek from Elizabeth Drive to Spavin Lake and back, it is about 15 minutes each way when following the red path on the map. There is a rich diversity of plant and bird life that can be seen all throughout this walk.

This walk is suitable of all ages and by following the purple path on the map large hills can be avoided so pushers and wheelchairs can be taken easily. The yellow path on the map shows a shorter walk suitable for puppies, older or injured dogs.

Near the far end of this walk there is a small playground and an open area to let dogs run and practice training.

At the lake there are some benches and bins so you can sit and watch the waterbirds swim around before heading back to your car.

Parking is easiest on Elizabeth Driven next to the park lands area, the road is wider to allow for parked cars. There is also an underpass so you can park on both sides of the road and cross quickly and safely.
